Policy 03.07, Calculation of Temporary Compensation

The Workers' Safety and Compensation Commission (WSSCC) of the Northwest Territories and Nunavut is currently reviewing Policy 03.07, Calculation of Temporary Compensation.

Comments

Policy 03.07 is undergoing review as part of the Governance Council's Comprehensive Policy Review Plan. The review of Policy 03.07 contributes to the Governance Council's strategic objective of *delivering quality services and outcomes* as found in its *2018-2022 Strategic Plan*.

Sections 38, 39, 40, 44, 45, 57, 58 and 59 of the *Workers' Compensation Acts* provide information that is legislated in the *Act(s)* regarding the calculation of temporary compensation when a claim is accepted.
